



## 2019 FARM SHARE

Our farm shares provide a diverse selection of seasonal vegetables to our members every week. Our last share of the season is a heavy share that includes extra storage items such as potatoes and winter squash that will allow our members to continue to eat locally even after the growing season is over. All of our produce is grown by us.

**When:** Our summer season is 20 weeks long starting the week of May 15 and running through the last full week in September.

**Where:** Our farm shares can be picked up at our market booth in Whitefish on Tuesdays 5-7:30p or at our new farm location on Fox Farm Trail (9 minutes to Costco) on Wednesdays 4-7p.

**Share Type:** We offer two share sizes: full share and partial share.

Our **FULL SHARE** costs \$500 with the option for a \$25 discount for signup and payment by March 25, 2019. The weekly box will contain 8-10 items that will vary based on what is in season. Example box: ½ pound Spinach, 1 pint Cherry Tomatoes, 1 bunch Beets, 1 head Napa Cabbage, 1 bunch Chard, 3 Cucumbers, ¾ pound Snow Peas, 1 bunch Carrots, 2 Kohlrabi.

Our **PARTIAL SHARE** costs \$350. The partial share will feature similar diversity to the full share but will be about 2/3 as many vegetables.

**Vacation/missed pickups:** If you are unable to pick up your share for any given week, please ask a friend to pick it up for you. We would also be happy to donate your share that week to the Food Bank if that is more convenient. If you have a preplanned vacation during the market season, we can prorate your share price. Dates must be chosen and confirmed with us prior to the start of the season. We do not offer a refund or make up for missed pickups.

**Growing Practices:** We often get asked if we are organic. Short answer... it depends on who you ask. We are NOT certified organic. We do, however, grow using sustainable, organic, and regenerative practices. This means that we do not use inorganic (“chemical”) fertilizers and instead build soil and fertility using compost, manure, cover crops, and natural soil amendments. It also means that we use natural methods to combat weeds and pests.
